§ 94.1 Demand registers

After April 1, 1939 no electric corporation shall purchase demand registers of the indicating type.

§ 94.2 Demand meters

Electric corporations shall not purchase indicating types of demand meters after the commission has approved suitable types of such meters equipped with cumulative registers or other means which permit the checking of the previous reading.

§ 94.3 Photographic record of readings

Subsequent to January 1, 1952 electric corporations shall maintain a photographic record of all readings taken from indicating types of demand meters and registers used to measure alternating current service.
