Subject: RE: Case 08-E-0077 - Entergy Petition - Ruling Issued Today

The County of Westchester believes that certain questions were not responded to and were claimed to be irrelevant by Entergy. Specifically, questions relating to the impact of certain assurances given regarding Vermont Yankee that could shift costs to other plants, in particular the three operating plants in NYS. The shifting of obligations to plants in NYS is certainly relevant to this proceeding. Accordingly, Westchester believes those questions should have been answered by Entergy. In addition, Westchester asked for a chart that showed the changes in the proposed organizational chart of Enexus. Westchester had clearly stated that it was not requesting just a copy of the new chart but a comparison showing how the changes relate to the previous organizational chart. Since there have been a number of changes and various parties have spent substantial time reviewing the prior versions it was felt it was only fair to show how these changes relate to the prior proposals. Instead, the parties were only provided with another copy of a revised chart. Entergy's attention to these matters would be appreciated.

There is also a general question that permeates this whole proceeding, to what extent does the representations of Entergy bind Enexus if the reorganization goes forward?
