Response:

No. TCCs are designed to insulate customers to the extent possible from responsibility for congestion costs. The TCCs associated with the grandfathered transmission facilities are not sold, and NYPA is fully reimbursed for congestion payments it pays to the NYISO. Other customers, on the other hand, are bearing congestion costs.
