NOTICE EXTENDING DEADLINES REGARDING FILINGS RELATED TO
DISTRIBUTED SYSTEM IMPLEMENTATION PLANS

(Issued September 4, 2015)

By letter dated September 3, 2015, the Department of Public Service Staff (Staff) requests two extensions related to the Distributed System Implementation Plans (DSIPs) in the proceeding referenced above.

First, Staff requests an extension until October 15, 2015 to file its detailed Guidance regarding the contents of DSIPs. Currently, Staff's DSIP Guidance is due September 8, 2015. Staff explains that the DSIP Guidance is foundational to the implementation of the vision described within the Track I Order in this proceeding. Staff requests additional time to file the DSIP Guidance because of the complexity of the issues presented as well as the concerns expressed by parties regarding the number of impending filings and comment deadlines in this proceeding.

Second, Staff requests an extension of the filing date for DSIPs by utilities until June 30, 2016. The utility filing is currently due on January 15, 2016. Staff anticipates that the Commission will seek comments on Staff's initial DSIP Guidance before issuing a final Guidance document, which will take additional time. Staff explains that the extension would provide sufficient time for a robust comment process and allow the utilities sufficient time to incorporate the final guidelines in their DSIPs.

This is to advise that Staff's requests for extension are granted in order to promote the fair, orderly and efficient conduct of this case. Accordingly, the deadline for Staff to file its DSIP Guidance is extended to October 15, 2015 and the deadline for utilities to file their DSIPs is extended to June 30, 2016.
