Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson") is herewith filing with the Commission a supplement to the exhibit accompanying the prepared direct testimony of the Energy Efficiency Panel in Cases 08-E-0887 and 08-G-0888. The supplement is designated at Exhibit \_\_\_ (EEP-4). Exhibit \_\_\_ (EEP-4) shows the evaluation plans for the proposed "Jurisdictional Gap" energy efficiency programs. Central Hudson has received a proposal for deployment of the Positive Home Energy Reporting System ("HERS")



from Positive Energy to provide services to both residential electric and gas customers over a 3 year period, and fill a portion or all of the 11,985 MWh savings originally set aside for Third Party proposals as detailed in Exhibit \_\_\_\_\_ (EEP-3) in Cases 08-E-0887 and 08-G-0888. Positive Energy has been working with Central Hudson (as well as other utilities), and Central Hudson has had multiple discussions with Positive Energy. Central Hudson requested that Positive Energy make certain adjustments to its original proposal, which were submitted to Central Hudson on September 12, 2008. Central Hudson continues to review the revised proposal, including exact program energy savings and costs, and anticipates filing a further report to the Commission and parties by October 8, 2008.
