Patrick Badgley is an associate editor with Platts' North American Natural Gas group. He has extensive experience analyzing US and Canadian gas and electricity markets and fundamentals. In addition to observing spot and forward market activity daily, Patrick focuses on price trends, coal-to-gas switching potential and other areas of demand, emerging supply sources and pipeline flow dynamics. Before joining Platts in 2010, Patrick reported and edited at several major US metropolitan newspapers. He is a graduate of the University of Texas at Austin.

King Look is the Director of Electricity Supply at Con Edison, responsible for the day-to-day electricity supply operations, electricity supply planning and procurement, management of contractual rights with various non-utility generators, and the development and implementation of Con Edison's electric and natural gas hedging programs. Mr. Look has over 30 years of experience in the utility business, which includes generation asset divestiture and valuation, peak demand forecasting, production cost modeling, system reliability modeling, economic analysis, and integrated resource planning.
