Notes from Staff (if applicable): Per Staff communication on 8/26/2014: Non-participant Spillover – Staff is not supportive of proceeding with this RFP at this time. Staff believes, in the context of the Reforming the Energy Vision (REV) and Clean Energy Fund (CEF) transition that may alter the NY energy efficiency program portfolio mix, the proposed study does not offer enough prospective value to justify proceeding with the effort, as currently envisioned. SBDI Impact Evaluation - Staff is not supportive of proceeding with this RFP at this time. Rather, Staff directs the PAs, in coordination with Staff, through the SBDI EM&V Review Subcommittee to review the SBDI EM&V studies already completed to: highlight common themes and contradicting findings amongst the reports; assess whether the current findings can be used to revise or verify the Technical Resource Manual (TRM); and determine if there are remaining information gaps and whether an alternative approach should be pursued. Residential Appliance Metering Study – The RFP was released on October 1, 2014 with proposals due December 3, 2014. Subcommittee has been involved with proposal review and contractor selection.
