Further ALJ Questions

47. Whether or not the Company previously received the letter from Mr. Irvine, what commitment, if any, is the Company willing to make to consider and make any necessary changes in response to the 11 numbered paragraphs under the caption "Blue Book?"

Response: The Company's "Blue Book" is a reference book that contains general specifications and guidelines for customer-owned electric service installations that will connect to the Company's electric delivery system. The Company completed a substantial review and revision of this reference book in January 2008.

With respect to the numbered comments submitted by Mr. Irvin, the Company provides the following responses:

#2 - "UL Approved" can be changed to "UL Listed".

#4 - can be corrected to "Conductors for General Wiring."

#5 - Each customer is supplied their available short circuit current on an individual basis.

#6 - The Company supplies fused voltage transformers.

#10 - The local unions provide training to their members working with electrical systems over 600 volts.

#11 - The Company can recommend that customers perform annual maintenance to their medium voltage equipment, but cannot mandate this as a requirement as O&R does not own the equipment.

Numbers 1, 3, 7, 8 and 9 will require more extensive review and investigation by the Company.
