

**Attestation for Energy Services Companies Not Intending to Serve Mass-Market
Customers
To Be Filed In Matter 19-02972**

I am an owner, partner, or officer of the business named below. I am familiar with the requirement set forth in the December 12, 2019 New York State Public Service Commission Order in Case No. 15-M-0127 that establishes that ESCOs that wish to retain eligibility to serve mass-market customers must submit updated eligibility applications by March 11, 2020, and I am aware that an ESCO that does not submit such an updated eligibility application will automatically lose any eligibility it once had to serve mass-market customers. The business named below has not submitted, and does not intend to submit, an updated eligibility application for the purpose of obtaining/retaining eligibility to serve mass-market customers. The business named below does not intend to market to or enroll mass-market customers after March 11, 2020.

I am also aware that, if the business named below decides, at any point in the future, that it wishes to serve mass-market customers, it will need to take appropriate steps and obtain eligibility to serve those customers.
