NOTICE OF STAKEHOLDER MEETING

(Issued January 22, 2020)

In its Order Adopting Changes to the Retail Access Energy Market and Establishing Further Process December 2019 Order), issued on December 12, 2019 in the above-captioned proceedings, the Commission directed development of financial assurance requirements for energy service company (ESCO) applicants as part of the eligibility criteria for ESCOs operating in New York State. The December 2019 Order directed Department of Public Service Staff (Staff) to consult with interested stakeholders, and to develop a proposal regarding the appropriate form such a financial assurance should take, as well as a methodology for calculating the required amount. Staff is directed to file a report with recommendations by Friday, April 10, 2020.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a Stakeholder Meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 26, 2020, beginning at 10:30 a.m. to discuss methodologies for assessing entry level and ongoing financial assurance requirements for ESCOs.
