Residential Appliance Metering Study:

The Residential Appliance Metering Study Project Team is happy to announce that a contract has been signed with DNV GL. The overall goal of the project is to help us better understand residential customer load profiles to support the development of energy efficiency programs, demand side management programs, smart grid, and all future energy planning in New York State. This project will be conducted in two phases where Phase I will test and validate the capability of non-intrusive load meters to accurately and reliably measure residential appliance loads, and to help with the design of the Phase 2 full-scale statewide study. Phase 1 will be located within National Grid and Con Edison territory with the goal of representing single family households, small-medium multi-family households and larger master metered buildings throughout the state in order to develop the Phase 2 design. Currently, the team is working to finalize the Phase 1 design with the goal of having meters installed within June/July.

Technical Manual Subcommittee:

The Tech Manual subcommittee has been engaged in completing the last edits and updates to various measures based on changes to: Federal standards, New York City (plumbing) code, and New York State Environmental Conservation Law. Changes were based on and completed/finalized impact evaluations. The measures being changed include: low-flow showerheads, recycled refrigerators/freezers, residential furnaces and boilers, commercial boilers: and residential and commercial lighting. These changes were emailed to the E² Working Group on May 20, 2015 to determine if there were any objections to the changes, consistent with the previous process. All changes will have an effective date of January 1, 2016.
