
This letter is in response to the request for comments on the above issue.

As the Supervisor in the Town of Huntington, I am naturally concerned with this issue as it pertains to those locations in Huntington that would be affected and the mechanism by which we would be notified as the custodians of safety issues for our residents. Relevant questions are:

- What sites (both facilities and general locations of streetlights) are located in the Town of Huntington?
- By what method could Huntington have access to annual reports due by February 15 on inspections and stray voltage testing? And would those reports be separated by location for easy access?
- Will the Town of Huntington be promptly notified (and how) of any positive stray voltage and the mitigation efforts involved for those stray voltage incidents?
- With regard to rate adjustments of 75 basis points for failure to achieve annual performance (page 7 of "Staff Proposal".) how does that affect ratepayers or is these fines rather than rate reductions?
