New York State Siting Board to Meet

Siting Board to Consider Amendments Related to Cassadaga Wind Project

ALBANY — The New York State Board on Electric Generation Siting and the Environment (Siting Board) will meet on Friday, April 26, 2019 at 1 p.m. to consider Cassadaga Wind LLC's request for an amendment to its Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need to expand the previously approved tree clearing window for site preparation.

On January 17, 2018, Siting Board approved Cassadaga Wind's request pursuant to Article 10 of the Public Service Law for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need, with conditions, to develop the Cassadaga Wind Project. The Project consists of, among other things, 48 wind turbines and associated facilities in the Towns of Arkwright, Charlotte and Cherry Creek in Chautauqua County, New York.

Members of the Siting Board will meet in the Public Service Commission's Board Room, 19th floor, 3 Empire State Plaza, Albany, New York, at 1 p.m., with video-conference connections to the Public Service Commission's Board Room, 4th floor, 90 Church St., New York, New York. In addition, the meeting will be webcast live on the Internet.

The Siting Board will consider whether to grant Cassadaga Wind's petition to allow tree clearing outside of the previously-approved tree-clearing window.

The meeting will be webcast to the Department's New York City offices. The webcasting will be for viewing and listening purposes only. In addition, the meeting will be webcast live on the Internet. The Internet webcast can be viewed by accessing <http://www.dps.ny.gov/Webcasts.html>

An agenda will be issued prior to this meeting, which will contain additional instructions regarding viewing in the New York City office and the webcast.
